ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Please establish that you meet Eligibility Requirements.

- A. Enrollment** - Candidates may be graduating high school seniors or other persons enrolling full-time in post-secondary schools for the first time.
- B. Residency** - Candidates must be residents of Bucks County in the State of Pennsylvania.
- C. Moyer Scholarship Qualifications** - Moyer Scholarships are intended for individuals who:
- (1) *are academically well qualified for the school they intend to attend;*
 - (2) *have a record of involvement in school, community, church and/or other activities (especially as a leader);*
 - (3) *have been involved in giving service to others;*
 - (4) *have financial need.*
- Gainful employment may be considered as a substitute for extensive involvement in leadership and service activities.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: Only those who submit all documents will be considered.

- **1.** Complete A. Marlyn Moyer, Jr. Scholarship **Application Form** (*pages 1-4*).
- **2.** a) Submit a **signed copy** of your own and a signed copy of your parents' or guardians' **Federal Income Tax Form #1040** or **Form #1040A** for the last tax year. Note: If parents are divorced or separated and are both providing support to the applicant, provide a copy of their Federal Tax Form #1040 or #1040A for the last tax year.
b) Submit a copy of your FAFSA Submission Confirmation Page with your EFC (Expected Family Contribution).
- **3.** Have your high school principal or guidance counselor complete and submit "one" **High School Reference Form**, a copy of your high school **Transcript**, and a copy of your **SAT or ACT test results** to the Moyer Foundation.
- **4.** Have someone who knows you well (other than a teacher, guidance counselor or relative) - an employer, friend of the family... - complete and submit "one" **Personal Reference Form**, to the Moyer Foundation.
- **5.** A photocopy of the **Financial Aid Award** offered to you by the school you will attend next fall. Note: Outside awards may result in the adjustment of one or more components of the financial aid package offered by your college/university. Please consult with your college/university on their outside award policy.

Note: These are the only documents that will be reviewed. Do NOT include any other documents.

DEADLINE: All forms, letters and other documents must be postmarked by **April 20, 2012.**

Applications postmarked after that date will **NOT** be considered.

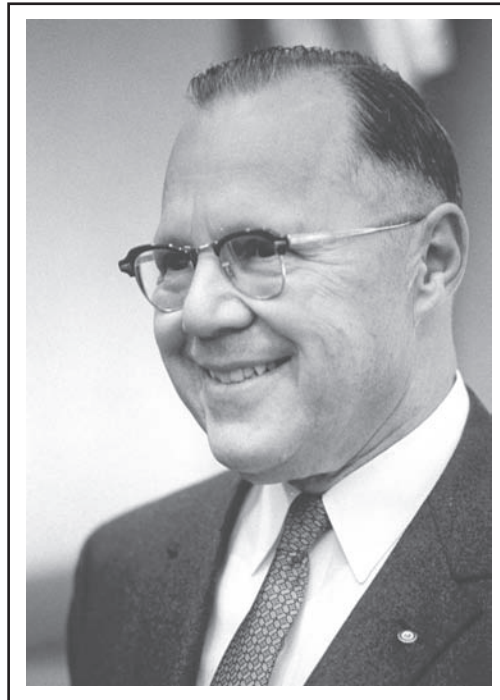

SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Your application materials will be reviewed by the Foundation Selection Committee. Following review all documents have been and will be completely shredded. Only candidates who submit all the required documents on time will be considered.
2. The Selection Committee gives special consideration to qualifications such as:
 - a) *involvement in community and/or religious activities (gainful employment is also considered)*
 - b) *strong academic records*
 - c) *involvement in school affairs*
 - d) *leadership*
 - e) *financial need*

Announcements of scholarship recipients ordinarily are made in June. Scholarship payments are made in August/September for the start of the fall term and sent directly to the educational institution. The application process is competitive and the number of awards is limited by the amount allocated. **Typically, six to eight scholarships are awarded each year averaging between \$2,500 and \$5,000.** As a measure of confidentiality and security, all application information is destroyed.

The A. Marlyn Moyer, Jr. Scholarship Foundation was established to honor a man who through his involvement and contributions to community activities in his native Bucks County exemplified dedication and excellence.

It is the intention and purpose of the Foundation to recognize and reward area students who exhibit the same high degree of community dedication and pursuit of excellence as Mr. Moyer by awarding them post-secondary scholarship awards.
